Attention Parents

Mason Youth Organization is now registering children, coaches, umpires and sponsors for the 2010 Baseball & Softball Season.

New for 2010 (Please see website for more details):

- MYO will hold 2 or 3 skills day camps on Sundays in March / April for all MYO baseball and softball players interested in developing a particular skill (pitching, catching, hitting, throwing, base running, etc.) highlighted at the camp. Please check our website in January for more details.
- In an effort to better distribute and train our older baseball players on Major League teams, MYO Little League will be holding mandatory player evaluations for all Major League Baseball Players American, National, Junior & Senior Leagues). Players will be evaluated on pitching, hitting, fielding and base running skills. All players will be placed on teams. MYO will maintain team continuity for teams returning a minimum of eight (8) players. However, teams returning less than eight (8) players may have players re-distributed. Evaluation will be held at SWOBAT on the following dates: Sat., February 6th (7:00-9:00pm), Mon., February 8th (6:00-8:00pm), and Thurs., February 18th (6:00-8:00pm).
- MYO Minor League Baseball (Pony Leagues, 7 & 8 year olds) is affiliating with Little League International for the 2010 season.
- MYO Little League Baseball (7-18 year olds) will be changing uniforms in 2010 to Majestic MLB Replica uniforms. Our Minor League teams (7-8 year olds) will be supplied with MLB Minor League Replica T-shirts and hats (such as the Louisville Bats). In Major league, our American and National divisions will have the corresponding MLB Major League (American and National) Replica T-shirts and hats. Junior & Senior Leagues will have a choice of Majestic MLB Replica uniforms.
- MYO Softball is reorganizing from Fast Pitch and Slow Pitch Leagues into a Junior "Coach Pitch" League (5-8 yr. olds) and Senior "Girl Pitch" League (9-18 yr. olds).
- MYO Softball will provide all girls with coordinating shorts as part of the uniform.
- MYO will once again have an Opening Day Celebration on May 1st (the rainout date is May 2nd). Please save the date. Check our website in 2010 for more details.
- MYO will once again be offering the Friday Night Pick-Up Game League as an alternative for boys ages 9-12 that do not want to play on a competitive team.
